
St. Patrick's Day & U'RE Lucky Day





It's now an ARL product having generated over \$300K in revenue and access to a significant number of silicon chip manufacturers. Money Weight Countertop Scales were used to count currency by measurement at the site of a former nuclear bunker known as Mount Pony in Culpeper, Virginia, where the Federal Reserve secretly stockpiled billions of dollars in cash to be used to reactivate the American economy in the event of a nuclear attack.

In 2007 the facility was converted to the Library of Congress's Packard campus for audio-visual conservation. It now provides underground storage for the library's vast collection of films and audio recordings.


