2001 In Review

2001 was a difficult year for the TyRex Technology Family. The technology downturn and subsequent restructuring, the September 11 events, and the death of our employee, Greg Villarreal, were all dramatic and tragic events never experienced by TyRex. The posi-



tive side of 2001 was TyRex's reaction to these extreme adversities. TyRex remained true to its core principles and philosophy, and verified and confirmed these values. TyRex's cultural commitments to longevity, profitability, and customer relationships, and our unique partnering program were proven to be sound and efficient during these troubled times.

In 2001 TyRex effectively reduced its overhead 50% without missing a customer ship date or losing a customer. This reduction allowed us to continue our monthly profitability of 49 consecutive months. Meanwhile, we increased our banking line of credit for 2002 with Comerica Bank by 50%, allowing us more opportunity for growth in 2002.

2002- The Future

My partner, John Bosch, and I believe the future for entrepreneurial-thinking companies and TyRex is now! Technology is a long term industry with tremendous growth. Megladon's team includes a chief scientist who is a PHD Physicist and has conducted fiber optic research for more than thirty years. The team also consists of a diverse group of former government lab, military, and university physicists that span the globe.

The HLC is only one of Megladon's new evolving technologies in the fiber optic industry. Megladon has recently completed the prototype stage and is set for production of its newest test equipment, the Optical Frequency Domain Reflectometry (OFDR), which can be used in conjunction with the HLC.


