<u>Deaton Engineering and TyRex Engineering Services Win Exclusive Testing Contract:</u> Deaton Engineering and TyRex Engineering Services have been working together closely to provide a 12-week turnkey project for the reliability engineering group of a major computer manufacturer.

The assignment was to automate a manual test to increase throughput and coverage for a variety of fans that are installed in desktop computers. Deaton Engineering provided the hardware design and development; TyRex Engineering Services created the necessary software.



A sample of various models of fans are collected from the customer's suppliers. These fans are then placed in a thermal chamber and tested for performance characteristics (frequency, voltage and current). The information collected is used to "trust but verify" the test data submitted from the fan suppliers. We are currently the only company that is authorized to perform this service.

Program Manager Curtis Anderson is working to get TyRex Engineering Services certified as a Third-Party Test Facility. We wish them luck and success as they continue to develop this relationship.

Jeff Walton was instrumental in these undertakings, as were Gregg Jackoskie and John Ho. Many thanks!






