

SabeRex Installs First Carbon M2 Printer in Texas

SabeRex partnered with Silicon Valley-based tech company Carbon to install the first-ever M2 additive manufacturing machine in the state of Texas at the beginning of August. With the installation of this printer, SabeRex is able to offer clients custom additive manufacturing solutions at scale – providing high-resolution 3D-printed parts with engineering-grade mechanical properties for a range of applications and industries.

The M2 is Carbon's second generation commercially available 3D printer that leverages Carbon's breakthrough technology, Digital Light Synthesis™, which is powered by its Continuous Liquid Interface Production (CLIP) process. Carbon's technology is faster than previous techniques and works with many types of plastics, including high-performance polymers like polyurethanes and epoxies. While other methods of 3D printing put down layers of plastics one at a time, Carbon printers fabricate products in a continuous process that increases the quality of the pieces produced.

Additionally, the M2 makes 3D printing relevant for manufacturing by increasing the speed at which products are delivered and providing availability of desired materials for the industrial market to apply in a wide range of applications. By partnering with Carbon to bring the M2 printer to Texas, SabeRex will play a major role in helping upend traditional methods of manufacturing through additive solutions.

TyRex Launches Bright Ideas Initiative


